At the call of the Chairperson, a special meeting of the Board of Directors of Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District of Los Angeles County will be held at the above time and place for the purpose of:

- 1. Approve Minutes of Regular Meeting Held February 11, 2015
- 2. Approve Warrants in Amount of \$598,548.12

<u>Summary</u>: The warrants issued by the local District are for costs incurred for operation and maintenance, such as electricity, water, telephone, and chemicals, and for relatively small capital projects. Expenditures are made in accordance with the guidelines established by the budget procedure and the purchasing policy that has been adopted by the Board.

3. Approve Departmental Invoice in Amount of \$1,255,541.72

<u>Summary</u>: A departmental invoice is an internal document that transfers each District's proportionate share of expenditures made by District No. 2, the administrative District, on behalf of the participating Districts in accordance with the authority granted through the approved annual budget and applicable joint powers agreement.

4. Consideration of Withdrawal of Currently Proposed Location for Deep Well Injection Element of the Chloride-Compliance Project and Direction to Staff to Evaluate Alternative Locations within Existing Schedule Established by California Regional Water Quality Control Board-Los Angeles Region (RWQCB)

<u>Summary</u>: The RWQCB and the United States Environmental Protection Agency are requiring the District to implement an advanced treatment project to comply with strict chloride discharge limits at the Valencia and Saugus Water Reclamation Plants. The project is required to be completed under a stringent schedule that includes milestones which, if missed, will result in significant fines to the District's ratepayers. One element of the compliance project is deep well injection of the brine (salt water) produced during the advanced treatment. Members of the public have expressed strong objections to the currently proposed location of the deep well injection site.

5. Authorize Issuance of Purchase Order to AMEC Foster Wheeler Environment and Infrastructure, Inc., (AMEC) in Amount of Approximately \$170,000 to Provide Geotechnical Investigation Services at Valencia and Saugus Water Reclamation Plants (WRPs) for Chloride Compliance Project

<u>Summary</u>: Geotechnical investigation services are required to support the design of foundations and subsurface structures for construction of advanced treatment facilities at the Valencia and Saugus WRPs. Proposals were solicited and received from five consulting firms. AMEC was ranked as the most qualified to provide the services and submitted the most cost-effective proposal.

6. Approve Plans and Call for Bids for Construction of Valencia Water Reclamation Plant (WRP) Entrance Improvements; Authorize Chief Engineer and General Manager to Establish Date for Receipt of Bids

<u>Summary</u>: The proposed project will improve safety at the existing entrance to the Valencia WRP by replacing the existing six-foot chain link security gate with an eight-foot wrought iron security gate and card reader. The entrance will be widened from 30 feet to 60 feet wide to allow safer ingress and egress of truck traffic at the site.

7. Report on Bids and Award of Contract for Installation of Air Conditioning Units for Switchboards 21, 41, and 61 at Valencia Water Reclamation Plant

Summary: Bid summary/recommendation to award is attached.
